



## EXTERNAL BURSARIES FOR 2017

The West Coast District Municipality will be offering bursaries for full-time studies at accredited tertiary institutions to youth residing in the West Coast Region. Candidates who will be registering for an undergraduate/postgraduate (PG) degree/diploma in one of the approved fields of study in 2017 are encouraged to apply.

### CRITERIA FOR EXTERNAL BURSARIES:

1. Youth - any persons between the ages of 18 and 25 years;
2. Students who meet the prescribed requirements of the academic institution;
3. Only students residing within the area of jurisdiction of the West Coast District Municipality;
4. Students studying at accredited South African academic institutions; and
5. The fields of study include the following: •Auditing / IT Auditing •Procurement Logistics •Chemical Engineering •Computer Science (with Network subjects) •Environmental Health (Specialisation in Air Quality and Radiation) •Civil Engineering.

Bursaries will cover registration, examination and class fees. Bursaries will be awarded with due regard to the Employment Equity Act, Skills Development Act, LGSETA guidelines on scarce skills, people with disabilities and other relevant legislative arrangements, and any other factors as may be determined by the Council.
