



OPPORTUNITY FOR SCHOOLGOING TEENAGERS IN THE WEST COAST TO ATTEND AN EDUCATIONAL CAMP IN GERMANY

This camp will be held from **14 - 24 July 2018 in Blankenburg, Germany**. The goal of the camp is to encourage tolerance between cultures, develop leadership, broaden learners' vision and expand learners' feeling of responsibility for the immediate environment to the rest of the world. Learners will also have an opportunity to spend a weekend with a German family.

The **requirements** which applicants must meet, are the following:

- They must be 14 to 17 years of age
- They must attend school in the West Coast region
- They must possess the following documents: passport and unabridged birth certificate (copy of documents or proof of application must be submitted)
- They must have leadership qualities
- They must be active in a school and community context

The full amount for attendance of the camp is **R15 000** and this includes flight and visa costs, a camp fee, and accommodation and meal costs for the duration of the camp. Of this amount, **50% must be paid by 31 March 2018**, while the other **50% must be paid by 30 April 2018**.

Process of selection: An interview by an independent panel after which the successful candidates will be informed.
