EXTERNAL BURSARY TOWARDS FURTHER STUDIES IN 2022 (Two Students)

Bursary applications are invited from first-year students for the 2022 academic year which will be extended to a maximum of three years provided that the candidates adhere to the bursary conditions. The bursary is restricted to full-time study at an accredited University or University of Technology. Preference will be given to individuals from historically disadvantaged societal groups or individuals with disabilities. **Parents/guardians or the student must reside within the West Coast Municipal Area.** The maximum estimated bursary amount for 2022 is R50 000 per student (excluding accommodation).

Applicants who intend to study for an undergraduate degree (NQF6 / NQF7) or national diploma (NQF6) in the following fields and whom have been accepted by a University or University of Technology will be considered:

- Economics
- Internal Auditing
- Risk Management
- Civil Engineering
